Larry Hughes's tenure as city manager has been focused on major community level projects, economic development and financial management. The completion of the City Square Project was an early success. City Square includes the Loy Harris Pavilion, a walkway along the railroad and the reuse of the Hopkins Candy Factory as a Center for the Arts.

Mr. Hughes has more than 40 years of local government experience including tenures as budget director of Richmond, Virginia; assistant to the budget director in Metropolitan Dade County, Florida; and assistant to the development director in Kansas City, Missouri.

He is married to Ms. Christina A. Frank. He has two sons, Todd and Alex and two daughters, Tanya and Lauren. The Hughes family lives in Manassas.

WOMAN OF THE YEAR SALLY LAY

Sally Lay has served as the Executive Director of the Center for the Arts of Greater Manassas/Prince William County for the past twenty three years. She has overseen the development of programming at the Center to include: The Pied Piper Children's Theatre, Pied Piper Theatre Camps, extensive arts education classes, the Summer Sounds Concert Series, and "Arts on the Go". She spearheaded a five-year campaign to win community, government and private support for the restoration of the old Hopkins Candy Factory, which would become the new home for the Center for the Arts in 2002. The Candy Factory houses an art gallery, classrooms and a multi use theater space.
